Amendment by Mr H. Austen Leigh —
That the present arrangement for the execution
of the duties of the Precentor be continued,
until the Provost and Officers shall have
considered the general question of the
position of the Organist.

Carried, Ayes 8, Noes 5 and the Provost.

Lay Clerks (b) Proposed by Mr Nixon — That two
additional Lay Clerks be appointed, and that
one be a Tenor voice at a salary of £100
a year.

Amendment by Mr Whitting — To
postpone the consideration of X (a) on the
Notice Paper until the next Shrove Tuesday
Meeting.

Carried, Ayes 12 and the Provost, Noes 5.

Choristers (c) Agreed (upon the recommendation of the
Committee appointed May 18, 1875) That
vacancies amongst the Choristers after Lady
Day next be opened to all candidates, whether
resident in Cambridge or elsewhere.

Agreed that Boys elected into the choir,
whose parents are not resident in Cambridge,
be provided with lodging at the expense of
the college.

Agreed that arrangements be made, if
possible, with Trinity and other colleges of the
University with the view of providing a joint
Boarding-house for such Choristers.
