RULES FOR THE CHORISTERS.

1. THE Choristers are forbidden to visit the rooms of any Member of the College without special permission.
2. They are forbidden, on pain of dismissal from the Choir, to receive any presents from Members of the University, or other persons resident in Cambridge, or to visit them, or to communicate with them by letter or otherwise, without special permission.
3. They are forbidden to loiter about the Courts of the College or the Streets; or to go out of bounds, or to enter any house without special permission.
4. They are forbidden to take part in public Concerts and musical performances without special permission.
5. They are forbidden to compete for vacancies in other Choirs; and it is understood that parents will not remove their boys from the School, without special permission.
6. Choristers twice failing in the Annual Examination will be liable to suspension or dismissal from their Choristerships.
7. Choristers failing from any cause except temporary illness to perform their duties in Chapel in a satisfactory manner will leave the Choir.
